- 1. The Level 4 discipline assessed Sectionman M. J. Haas for alleged insubordination and Union Pacific Rule 1.6 Conduct for an incident that happened on July 29, 1997 was without just and sufficient cause, arbitrary, capricious and in violation of the Agreement (System File D-296/1105823).
- 2. As a consequence of the violation referred to in Part (1) above, Sectionman M. J. Haas shall now be afforded the remedy outlines in Rule 48(h).

FINDINGS:
