STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Appeal of the discipline of a 4-day suspension imposed on Justin Macko.

<u>FINDINGS</u>; This dispute arose as a result of the Carrier charging the claimant with the following offense:

"Your alleged violation of Canadian National / Illinois Central Railroad On-Track Safety Rules effective June 2nd, 2002, Rule 100 which reads as follows:

SECTION 1: INTRODUCTION

100. Fouling the Track

Each roadway worker is responsible for determining that on-track safety is provided before fouling any track or assuming a position from which he or she could potentially foul a track.

A roadway worker or roadway machine is fouling a track within four feet of the field side of the near running rail.

This incident occurred when you parked Aspen Truck #572346 within the four foot fouling point at Milepost 102.5, Holly subdivision, and were struck by Train 393 traveling West at approximately 12:25 pm on September 18th, 2003 causing damage to the passenger side door and fender of the vehicle."

At the September 23, 2003 formal investigation, the claimant was forthright and admitted that he made a mistake by parking his truck too close to the track with the door left open, and took full responsibility for fouling the track. Therefore, based on claimant's admission of guilt, the Board concludes the Carrier did not misuse its discretion when it assessed discipline, thus I will not intervene in this matter.
