BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES
vs
BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE GALVESTON WHARVES

Index-33-71

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement on August 8 and 9, 1966 by assigning or otherwise permitting the Kane Pipe Works to operate it's own truck crane with it's own operator on P-14 at Galveston Wharves, in the performance of certain work of unloading dredging pipe from trucks and loading same on a barge.
2. Hoist Helper K. E. Cotton be now compensated for 8 hours pay at his respective rate on each of the dates referred to in part 1 of this claim.

OPINION OF BOARD:

The decision in this case is governed by Award No. 1 of this Board.
