Statement of Claim: Claim of Engine Foreman W. R. Thacker, Jr., Helpers E. D. King and R. M. Darnell, Council Bluffs, for eight hours at the pro rate yard rate of pay, March 28, 1970. \_\_\_\_

Findings: In this case involving the interchange delivery of one car by claimant yardmen to the I.C.'s non-designated Levee Track in Council Bluffs, the only other undisputed fact is that at the time of delivery the (designated for interchange; Speedway Track was clear. The Parties are in conflict in respect to whether (1) there was available space on designated primary Track No. 7 or on designated secondary Track No. 10; and (2) in case the car had been left on the Speedway, there would have been an open "escape" track on which claimants could have gotten home.

In these days of individual confusion, national uncertainty, international insecurity, and cosmic befuddlement, the Board is impelled here to say the hell with it.

AWARD:

Claim dismissed.
