PARTIES

DISPUTE:

Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employes

and

Consolidated Rail Corporation

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. Carrier violated the Rules Agreement effective April 15, 1944, as amended, when from 7:30 a.m. to 3 p.m. each day, April 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, 13, 14 and 15, 1977. Area Foreman Clarence Nixon performed a Trackman's duties of gauging and replacing ties on Tracks 22, 26, 54, 56 and 14, Oak Island, New Jersey.
- 2. As the result of such violations, claimant Francisco Santos be compensated one day's pay at the Trackman rate for each day the violation occurred.

FINDINGS:

Substantially the same issue, contentions and evidence were before us when we issued Award No. 24.

What we had to say in that Award is equally applicable here.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
