Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employes

and

Consolidated Rail Corporation

OF CLAIM:

- (a) The Carrier violated the Rules Agreement effective April 15, 1944, as modified September 1, 1949, January 22, 1974 and March 4, 1976, particularly Rules 1-Scope, 2-Seniority, 2-d-3-Seniority Districts, 2-e-1 and others, when six (6) former CRR of NJ unprotected Trackmen were used on the former Lehigh Valley Railroad in the South Plainfield Gang area, blacktopping crossings, between 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. each day, April 6 and 7, 1977.
- (b) As the result of such violation, Trackmen:
 F. Swarrow, J. Loughlin, J. Crane, E. McDonald,
 A. Melone, and Trackman-driver F. Santos, be
 compensated at the applicable rate, for each day
 the violation occurred.

FINDINGS:

Petitioner has not established that ineligible employes actually performed the work in dispute, an essential element of its claim. The claim will accordingly be denied. See Award No. 29.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
