

PUBLIC LAW BOARD NO. 249

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES

vs.

NORFOLK AND WESTERN RAILWAY CO.

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement when it failed and refused to allow mileage to Mr. Billy Binnion between his headquarters and his work location on May 10, 13, 17, 20, 24, 27 and 31, 1968.

2. Claimant Binnion now be reimbursed for 543 miles at 9¢ per mile.

OPINION OF BOARD:

Since Claimant Binnion held no seniority in the class in which he was temporarily used at another location, and since he was not allowed meal and lodging expenses for his Saturday and Sunday rest days, he is entitled to be paid for the mileage expense claimed.


AWARD:


Claim sustained.
