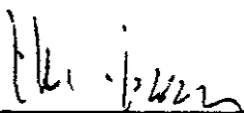
STATEMENT

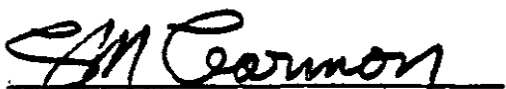
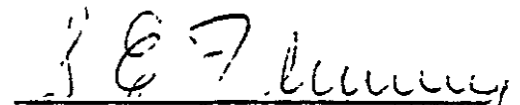
FINDINGS
