STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the
Brotherhood that:


- (1) The Carrier violated the Agreement when it required Relief Foreman A. Watts to assume the work load of two vacationing foremen (Track Gang #1 and Section 107) on June 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 14, 15, 16, 17 and 18, 1965.
- (2) The Carrier now pay A. Watts ten (10) days' pay at the rate of the foreman's position at Section 107, Eugene, Oregon."

FINDINGS:


The Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:
