STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. The Agreement was violated when, on April 27 and 28, 2012, the Carrier assigned Welder J. Hunter to flag and watch a bridge at Mile Post 000294.4 on the Nashville Division and failed to properly assign such work to Claimant C. Scott.
- 2. As a consequence of the violation referred to in Part 1 above, Claimant C. Scott shall now be compensated for the fourteen (14) hours worked by Welder J. Hunter.

FINDINGS:

The Board, upon consideration of the entire record and all of the evidence, finds that the parties are Carrier and Employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as amended, that this Board is duly constituted by Agreement dated March 20, 2008, this Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein, and that the parties were given due notice of the hearing held.

The parties have advised the Board that this dispute has been settled on the property. As there is no longer a matter in controversy, the claim must be dismissed.

AWARD: Claim dismissed.
