Claim on behalf of W. M. Barnwell requesting exoneration of his thirty (30) day deferred suspension with a probationary period of twelve (12) months and S. L. McDarris requesting exoneration of his twenty (20) day deferred suspension with a probationary period of nine (9) months that resulted from the November 13, 1996 formal investigation for their failure to use required fall protection on Thursday, October 24, 1996, while working on Burnley Station Road overhead bridge at MP-99.14.
