2. Carrier be required to compensate the senior idle telegrapher (extra in preference) for one day's pay (8 hours) on the above date.

FINDINGS: This claim, except for the date involved, is founded upon facts identical to those involved in Docket 81. For the reasons stated in our Findings in that docket we find that this claim should be denied.
