SPECIAL BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT NO. 166

BROTHERHOOD OF RAILIAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES Versus MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement when, on October 19, 1956, Key Punch Operator Mrs. Joanne Heinzer was absent from duty account summoned by the Board of Election Commissioners to serve in canvassing voters in the precinct to which assigned and it refused to pay her for the day, contrary to and in violation of the provisions of Rule 39 of the Clerks' Agreement:
- 2. That Mrs. Joanne Heinzer shall be paid for the day, Friday, October 19, 1956, at her pro rata rate of \$15.52, account deduction having been made from the payroll improperly.

FINDINGS: While existing facts in this claim are not identical with those present in Docket No. 23, said claim under consideration here involves the same parties and the same rules as were present in Docket No. 23, Award No. 23, previously considered by this Board.

It is the opinion of the Board that the controlling factual situation here present, when considered in the light of the cited rules, is comparable to that considered and applied in the aforesaid award. For the reasons stated and to the extent indicated in Award No. 23, this claim is denied.

AWARD: Claim denied.
