STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood:

(1) That Carrier violated the Clerks' current Agreement when it failed to compensate Messrs. J. A. Loucks, John W. Tyler, B. F. Brown, W. T. Koen and Leslie McConnell, Florida Street Station, St. Louis, Missouri, at punitive rate of pay for work in excess of eight hours in a day.

(2) That the above named Claimants be paid the difference between pro rata rate of pay and punitive rate of pay of the positions they worked, in excess of eight hours in a day, on March 16, 1954, April 4, 1954, April 19, 1954, April 17, 1954 and March 27, 1954, respectively.

FINDINGS: The principle involved in this case was disposed of in Award No. 11, which denied a similar claim.

AWARD: Claim denied.
