BROTHERHOOD OF RAILWAY AND STEAMSHIP CLERKS, FREIGHT HANDLERS, EXPRESS AND STATION EMPLOYES versus

THE CENTRAL RAILROAD COMPANY OF NEW JERSEY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that,

- (a) Carrier violated certain rules of the Clerks' Agreement when they took work from the effice of Superintendent Transportation which was performed by J. Sullivan and unilaterally transferred this work to Clerk-Stenographer in the office of Elizabethport Locomotive and Car Shops. The transfer of this work was done without due conference, notification or concurrence as required by the rules of the Clerks' Agreement, and
- (b) Clerk-Stenographer G. Krasnick be compensated at the time and one-half rate of her position for all time spent in performing this work from November 10, 1955, and
- (c) Clerk-Stenographer G. Krasnick have her rate adjusted for performing higher rated work transferred to her and this adjustment be handled in accordance with the provisions of the Clerks! Agreement.

FINDINGS

Here Carrier discontinued one method of record keeping and information gathering which proved impractical and devised better and simpler methods of such record keeping. That does not constitute a transfer of work and there is no showing in this docket that under Rule 27(e) claimant is entitled to a rate adjustment.

AWARD

Claim denied.
