BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES versus MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

Claim of the System Committee that:

"We feel the Carrier's dismissal of Trackman Johnnie Cunningham was too severe and the penalty excessive and we are requesting the carrier shall now reinstate Mr. Cunningham to service on a leniency basis with all rights unimpaired, but without pay for time lost."

FINDINGS:

This is a claim for leniency. NRAB awards have consistently held that the board is without authority to entertain such claims.

Moreover, it appears that the Carrier herein offered reinstatement on a leniency basis and that the claimant rejected it.

AWARD:

Claim dismissed.
