OF CLAIM:


Claim of the Committee that:


1. Carrier violated the effective Agreement by unfairly dismissing Trackman T. G. Scott from Carrier's service on May 24, 1978.
2. Claimant Scott shall be paid for eight hours each work day and holiday, at the straight time rate of pay for trackmen, to begin on May 11, 1978, (when he was withheld from service) and to continue until such time as he is returned to work with seniority rights and vacation privileges restored, unimpaired.


FINDINGS: The parties stipulated that this claim be withdrawn.

AWARD: Claim withdrawn.
