STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

Claim of the Committee that:

1. Carrier violated the effective Agreement when Trackman B. J. Sturch was unjustly dismissed by letter dated October 7, 1978.
2. Claimant B. J. Sturch shall be paid for eight hours each work day and holiday, at the straight time rate of pay for trackmen, to begin on September 18, 1978, when he was withheld from service, and to continue until such time as he is returned to work.


FINDINGS:



