BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES
versus
MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the agreement on July 1, 1980, as result of investigation of Trackmen W. J. Mitchell and W. C. Smith, System Rail Gang 6801, for allegedly being absent without proper authority subsequent to May 7, 1980, and failure to comply with the Chief Engineer's instructions dated May 8, 1980.
2. Claimants shall now be returned to service with seniority and other rights unimpaired, with pay for all time lost beginning July 1, 1980.


FINDINGS:

At the hearing the Carrier agreed to reinstate the Claimants on a leniency basis without pay for lost time.
