STATEMENT  
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the agreement on November 13, 1981, when Trackman H. L. Fonby, Jr., was dismissed for allegedly failing to protect his assignment on Gang No. 5801, September 9, 1981.
2. Claimant shall be allowed pay for all time lost beginning November 13, 1981, until reinstated to service.


FINDINGS:
