STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:


"(1) Carrier violated the agreement on April 20, 1984 when Trackman H. B. Jones, System Rail Gang, was removed from service on April 20, 1984 for his reporting to his assignment under the influence of intoxicants.

"(2) Claimant shall now be returned to service with all rights unimpaired and paid for all time lost beginning April 20, 1984."

FINDINGS: Claimant signed a resignation and there is no evidence to support the charge that it was obtained by coercion, so the claim is not sustainable.

AWARD: Claim denied.
