Statement

of Claim: (1) Claim in behalf of System Bridge Gang Carpenter E. C. Mitchell, dismissed from service on April 24, 1989.

(2) Claim in behalf of Mr. Mitchell for wage loss beginning March 27, 1989, and continuing until he is reinstated with seniority, vacation and all other rights unimpaired.


Findings: The Board has jurisdiction of this case by reason of the parties Agreement establishing this Board therefor.


This is a companion claim to that found in our Award No. 423 the findings of which by reference is incorporated herein. However, Claimant was properly and fairly discharged from service. Because of the unusual circumstances involved the Board will reinstate the Claimant to service with all rights unimpaired but without pay for the time out of service. He is required to pass the necessary return to service physical examinations.

Award: Claim disposed of as per findings.
