STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. The Carrier violated the Agreement dated July 1, 1967, especially Rule 7-17, when it cut the expenses of welders and welder helpers from actual necessary expenses to \$2.15 a day as provided for certain classes of employes in the August 8, 1969 Agreement, which placed into effect Section 2, in conjunction with Section 1 of the Agreement dated March 7, 1969, relating to the application of Section 1 of the Award of Arbitration Board No. 298, NMB Case A-7948.
- 2. The Carrier shall now reimburse Welder J. R. Melton for the difference between actual necessary expenses in the amount of \$44.54, which the Carrier denied October 10, 1969, and the \$2.15 a day beginning September 2, 1969 through September 30. And subsequent dates.
- 3. The Carrier shall be required to pay, in addition to the money amounts claimed herein, an additional amount of 10% per annum compounded annually on the anniversary date of the claim.

FINDINGS:

The issue to be determined in this dispute is identical to that in our Award No. 130 and the Board is governed accordingly.

Sections 1 and 2 of the claim are sustained. Α.

Section 3 of the claim is denied.

Carrier is directed to make payment within thirty (30)

days of the date of the award.
