AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 5

STATEMENT

OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

 (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement when, on October 5, 1955, it assigned other than Bridge and Building Mechanics to perform the work of painting two (2) Air Tanks at Washington, Indiana;

 (2) B&B Mechanic George R. Taylor now be allowed four (4) hours' straight time pay account of the violation referred to in part one (1) of this claim."

FINDINGS: The issues, the contentions and the rules in Docket No. 5 being the same as in Docket No. 4, decided by the Award in Docket No. 4, we will, for the reasons set forth in that Award sustain the claim.
