## SPECIAL BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT NO. 305

THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
WE.
MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY
(Oulf District)

STATEMENT- OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Missouri Pacific Railroad (Oulf District), that:

- (1) Carrier violated the Agreement in failing and refusing to allow L. C. Poulan, who was on vacation August 30 to Septembar 17, 1957 (inclusive), proper compensation in accordance with Agreement rules, for such vacation period.
- (2) Carrier shall now be required to pay L. C. Poulan, in addition to amount heretofore allowed, an additional sum equivalent to eight hours at time and one-half pro rate rate for such vacation period.\*

OPINION OF BOARD:

Claim is made for pay at the time and one-half rate, for one day, September 2, 1957, such day being Labor Day, a holiday recognised by the parties to the Agreement.

Claimant during his allowed vacation period, August 30 to September 17, 1957, was relieved properly, but has made claim for all allowances paid the relief operator during such period. On September 2, 1957, this being Labor Day, and a regular work day on claimant's assignment, the Carrier allowed the relief operator pay at the pre-rate rate for one day plus time and one-half for one day as provided by the Agreement for holiday service. Carrier did not allow the incumbent claimant the holiday time and one-half pay.

It is alleged by the Organization and not disputed by Carrier, that the claimant herein was regularly assigned to a position which required service to be performed seven days a week, and it is alleged by the Organization and conceded by Carrier that the occupant of the said position had heretofore been required to work on holidays. The Beard is of the opinion that such work on the day involved here, constitutes assigned evertime on the position rather than casual or unassigned evertime. This being true, such assigned evertime should be included in the compensation paid the employe while on vacation during the period involved.

FINDINGS: Claim here is supported by facts and circumstances similar to those in Award No. 1. Special Board No. 239, on this property.

AWARD: Claim sustained.
