SPECIAL BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT NO. 355

PARTIES: THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties hereto when on June 14 and 24, 1957, it caused, required and permitted train service employes not covered by the Telegraphers' Agreement to copy train order at Piedmont, West Virginia, over the telephone at Piedmont via the operator at West Keyser, West Virginia.

2. Carrier be required to compensate an idle operator, extra in preference, pay for one day (8 hours) on each date listed.

FINDINGS:

The issue is covered by our Award in Dockets Nos. 7 and 9. This claim will be sustained.
