AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 105

STATEMENT  
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it improperly compensated F. H. Scott for a vacation allowance, September 7 to 27, 1959.
2. Carrier shall be required to compensate F. H. Scott for 23 hours and 55 minutes at the time and one-half rate in addition to amount already paid for vacation allowance.

FINDINGS:

Overtime required and assigned on 46 of 65 available working days in the 13 weeks between August 24 and November 14 cannot be held to be "casual or unassigned overtime."
