THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 105

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when it improperly compensated F. H. Scott for a vacation allowance, September 7 to 27, 1959.
- 2. Carrier shall be required to compensate F. H. Scott for 23 hours and 55 minutes at the time and one-half rate in addition to amount already paid for vacation allowance.

FIND INGS:

Overtime required and assigned on 46 of 65 available working days in the 13 weeks between August 24 and November 14 cannot be held to be "casual or unassigned overtime."

AWARD

Claim sustained.
