AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 122

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on March 2, 3, 4 and 9, 1960, it required or permitted employes at Fairmont, West Virginia, not covered by said Agreement, to use the telephone to communicate direct with the train dispatcher.
2. Carrier shall be required to compensate idle operators at Fairmont in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on each of the dates set forth above.

FINDINGS:

We will follow our awards in Dockets 34 and 119, among others, and issue a denial award in this claim.
