AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 251

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when, on July 25, 1961 it required or permitted employees not covered by the Agreement to transmit and/or receive a message between Cincinnati, Chio and Louisville, Kentucky.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate Operator T. Babbs, Jr., in the amount of a day's pay (8 hours) on July 25, 1961.

FINDINGS:

Carrier had two western ownership cars at the K and IT freight yard in Louisville. A clerk in Carrier's Transportation Office at Cincinnati telephoned Louisville to direct that the two cars in question be billed to Columbus, Ohio General Depot for reconsignment to Los Angeles.

This is similar to the claim disposed of by our Award No. 229. We will, accordingly, issue a sustaining Award.
