AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 255

- STATEMENT 1. Carrier violated the agreement between the OF CLAIM: parties when on December 22, 1961, it required or permitted an employee not covered by the agreement to communicate direct with the train dispatcher during a time when the agent-operator at Gassaway, West Virginia, was off duty during his meal hour.
 - 2. Carrier shall compensate Agent-Operator E. R. Brunt for one hour at the overtime rate on December 22, 1961.
- FINDINGS: The contents of the protested telephone conversation were such as to fall within the definition of "message". It was definitely concerned with the makeup of a train and the movement of the cars which made up the train.
