OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on February 14, 1957, it required or permitted an employee not covered by the Agreement to use the telephone and transmit a message at North Lima, Ohio.
2. Carrier shall compensate an idle operator in the amount of a day's pay (eight hours) on February 14, 1957.

FINDINGS:
