STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on March 2, 1959, it required or permitted the conductor on a work train to use the telephone at Stewarton, Pennsylvania to secure permission to cross over and to report in the clear.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate Operator L. J. Show in the amount of one day's pay (8 hours) on March 2, 1959.

FINDINGS:

We will here follow our action in Docket No. 80 and, for the reasons therein cited, deny this claim.
