Parties: THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS
THE BALTIMORE AND OHIO RAILROAD COMPANY

AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 86

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties hereto when on February 13, 1957, it caused, permitted and required a crossing watchman to furnish lineups on trains to employes of the Philadelphia Transit Company who were working on overhead wires at Darby, Pennsylvania.
2. Carrier be required to compensate an idle operator, extra in preference for one day's pay (8 hours) on February 13, 1957, because of said violation.

FINDINGS:

A careful reading of this record leads us to the inescapable conclusion that under the circumstances, the Interpretation to Article 34 obtains. A sustaining Award is in order.
