STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- Carrier violated the Agreement between the parties when on November 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16, 1956, it required or permitted a Clerk, an employe not covered by the Telegraphers' Agreement, to relieve J. W. McMillion, Assistant Agent, Fell Street, Baltimore, Maryland, for his vacation.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate the senior, idle employe covered by the Telegraphers' Agreement for a day's pay (8 hours) for November 12, 13, 14, 15, and 16, 1956.

FINDINGS:

The facts in this case justify a sustaining award for the reasons set forth in our Findings in Docket No. 93.

## AWARD

Claim sustained as to violation. Claim for payment denied on the basis that there was no senior idle employee covered by this Agreement on the dates in question.
