THE ORDER OF RAILROAD TELEGRAPHERS) vs) NEW YORK CENTRAL RAILROAD, EASTERN DISTRICT) (except Boston and Albany Division) and) NEW YORK DISTRICT)

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. Carrier violated the terms of the agreement between the parties when, on August 9, 1961, without just cause, it dismissed George Tallchief, from service.
- 2. Carrier shall now be required to restore George Tallchief to service without loss of seniority and compensate him for all time lost.

OPINION OF BOARD:

The record discloses that Claimant Tallchief was properly notified of the precise charge filed against him by the Carrier, that a fair and impartial hearing was held on this charge, and that the evidence adduced at the hearing supports said charge. We find that Claimant was dismissed from service for just cause.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
