AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 55

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement on August 23, 1962, by assigning a class "A" Work Equipment Operator to the work of a Trackman in Extra Gang unloading welded rail with the work train on Sub-Division 2, while furloughed Extra Gang trackman L. F. Watson was available for service, but not used.
- (2) Trackman L. F. Watson be now compensated for this one day's pay at his respective trackman's rate."

FINDINGS: Here we have a situation similar to that in Docket No. 53, and for the reasons there cited, we will sustain this claim.

AWARD: Claim sustained.
