AWARD IN DOCKET NO. 58

STATEMENT OF CLAIM: "Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

(1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by employing outside parties, a contractor, on June 26, 27, and 28, 1962, to paint the office of the Staten Island Rapid Transit Railway Company and the adjoining toilet rooms at 2 Victory Boulevard, Staten Island, New York.

(2) Painters Sebastian Russo and Frank Flagello be now reimbursed for 3 days' pay at their respective rate account of this referred-to violation of the Agreement."

FINDINGS: For the reasons set forth in our Award in Docket No. 56, a sustaining Award is required here.

AWARD: Claim sustained.
