SPECIAL BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT NO. 541

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES And ERIE LACKAWANNA RAILWAY COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- 1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by failing to continue Carpenter Helper Mr. Russell Badger in his position as Carpenter Helper-Truck Driver, in Carpenter Gang, beginning March 16, 1964, and continuing.
- 2. Carpenter Helper Mr. Russell Badger be compensated for all hours involved from March 16, 1964, until this condition has been corrected.

FINDINGS:

The present dispute and that involved in Award 31 concern the same issue, agreement and contentions, and substantially the same factual situation. The fact that Award 31 concerned a plumbing crew that had dwindled to three men, while here there is a carpenter gang that had been reduced to five employes (a foreman, leader and three carpenters) does not affect the case or call for a different result. No new evidence or rule has been brought to our attention and, in line with our holding, in Award 31, we will deny this claim.

AVARD: Claim denied.
