STATFMENT OF CLAIM:

"Claim of the General Committee of The Order of Railroad Telegraphers on the Reading Company that:

- Carrier violated and continues to violate the agreement between the parties when it fails and refuses to pay S. N. Gentile, Agent Rydal-Southhampton for time spent in excess of eight hours travelling to "home" station.
- 2. Carrier shall compensate S. N.Gentile in the amount of twenty minutes pay, at the rate of his position, each work day Monday through Friday commencing March 1, 1960 and continuing thereafter until the violation is corrected."

FINDINGS:

It appears that all claims for damage account working a dual station assignment were disposed of by settlement agreements, between the parties, made subsequent to the date of this claim pursuant to the awards of Special Board of Adjustment No. 327. Thus this claim is not valid.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
