- 2. In consequence of its action, Carrier shall now compensate Mr. J. H. White-side for eight hours at the pro rata rate of pay of the Clerk-Telegrapher position, Rector, Arkansas, for Thursday, May 24, 1956.

FINDINGS: Under the facts in this case it is developed that claimant lost no time because of change in the starting hours of his assignment.

AWARD: Claim denied.
