Parties to Dispute:

Brotherhood of Maintenance of Way Employees

and

Norfolk Southern Railway Company

Statement of Claim:

Claim on behalf of W. R. Wilson requesting the removal of a ten-day suspension assessed for failure to properly report an on-duty injury of May 24, 1991, as required by General Rule N and General Safety Rule 1000 of the Norfolk Southern Safety and General Conduct Rules.
