FINDINGS: The Board, upon the whole record and all the evidence, finds that:

The Carrier or Carriers and the employee or employees involved in this dispute are respectively Carrier and Employee within the meaning of the Railway Labor Act, as approved June 21, 1934.

The Board has jurisdiction over the dispute involved herein. The parties to said dispute were given due notice of hearing thereon.

In view of the disparity between recital contained in the force reduction notices issued to claimants wherein it was acknowledged that they were regularly assigned to the freight handler classification, and the Carrier contention here advanced that each of them worked as an extra on a day to day basis, the conflict in the evidence, in this particular case, will be resolved in claimants' favor.

AWARD: Claim sustained.
