- (a) Clerk Myron Dubee, and all others affected by the abolishment of position of Clerk, Taylor, Pa., be compensated for all loss of wages due to improper abolishment of position, and
- (b) Position of Clerk, Taylor, Pennsylvania be properly restored.

FINDINGS

The Board has agreed that this claim should be disposed of by paying Clerk Myron Dubee, and all others affected by the abolishment of the Clerk's position at Taylor, Pa. on January 11, 1954, and they be compensated for all loss of wages due to such abolishment from January 11, 1954 to May 1, 1954 without establishing any precedent.
