- (a) Carrier violated Article II, Section 3 of the National Agreement of August 21, 1954 when they failed to grant holiday pay to employes (furloughed employes) who shape out and worked continuously prior and after the holidays, i.e., Decoration Day, Fourth of July, Labor Day and subsequent holidays, and
- (b) That employes Richard Anderson, P. Zientak, Norman Mosby, T. Brown, C. Terranova and other affected employes be paid one day's pay each or average incentive or tonnage earnings, as the individual case may be, for the holidays mentioned in this claim.

FINDINGS
