STATEMENT

OF CLAIM: Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

1. The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by failing to assign the senior qualified Mechanic S. C. Burnett to operate Bridge Crane No. X-512 during the period of June 6 to 17, 1960, inclusive, while the regular operator was on vacation.

2. The Carrier shall now reimburse Claimant S. C. Burnett for the difference in the pay he received at his regular rate as a Mechanic and what he should have received as a Hoisting Engineer during the period referred to in this claim.

FINDINGS:

Disposition of this claim is governed by the principles enunciated in our Award No. 87.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
