BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES  
versus  
MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT  
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the effective Agreement when System Rail Gang Trackmen Allen J. Anderson, David Bahe, Larry Begay, Roy Begay, Roger Benally, Tom P. Bitsue, Buster H. Burton, Bennie Chee, Disio Chee, Leonard Gonnies, Paul Jumbo, Jimmie Lee, Tully Lee, Larry Mexicano, Gilbert Nez, Joe J. Roanhorse, Justin Robertson, Jerry Sandoval, Jack Begay, Watson Tolth, Chee J. Topaha, Frank Yazzie, Gilbert Yazzie and Roger Yazzie were improperly withheld from service.
2. Claimants shall now be compensated for all time lost at their respective rates of pay from June 6, 1980 to June 21, 1980, both dates inclusive.


FINDINGS:


