STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

Claim of the System Committee of the Brotherhood that:

- (1) The Carrier violated the effective Agreement by refusing to allow Crossing Watchman O. A. Kassebaum to work his regular assignment at Michigan Avenue, St. Louis, Missouri, on February 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 1958.
- (2) Crossing Watchman Kassebaum be compensated his regular day's pay on each of the dates referred to in this claim.

FINDINGS: The above claim has been settled by the parties and withdrawn from consideration by the Board.

AWARD: Claim dismissed.
