BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYEES
versus
MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT
OF CLAIM:

1. Carrier violated the agreement on January 3, 1981, because Trackman R. W. Nichols, a junior man, performed service on the Louisiana Division during the period when Trackman W. Fair, Jr., was available.
2. Claimant shall now be allowed eight hours for each work day and for overtime work performed by the junior trackman beginning January 3, 1981, and continuing until the claimant is permitted to work.

FINDINGS:

It appears that claimant had no seniority rights on the Louisiana Division so there is no valid basis for his claim.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
