SPECIAL BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT NO.

BROTHERHOOD OF MAINTENANCE OF WAY EMPLOYES versus MISSOURI PACIFIC RAILROAD COMPANY

STATEMENT OF CLAIM:

- Carrier violated the agreement on September 1, 1981, when Trackmen C. B. Ross and J. H. Thomas, Kingsville Division, were dismissed for refusal to comply with instructions to change a flat tire on the gang truck on July 16, 1981.
- 2. Claimants shall now be allowed pay at their straight time rate during the period July 17, 1981 until September 1, 1981.

FINDINGS:

While there is a conflict in the evidence adduced at the investigation, we are obliged to find that there was evidence which supports the charge. Considering the prior discipline record and . relatively short service of the claimants. dismissal was not an excessive penalty so the claim is not sustainable.

AWARD:

Claim denied.
